4. Project/Program Description

NE 191st St, NE 29th Ave, and NE 188th St, collectively referred as NE 191 St. System, is a very low-lying area prone to flooding at every storm event. As current tides rise due to sea level rise, the capacity to discharge into the Bay and the groundwater system is progressively diminishing, and flooding is getting worse. Roadways are becoming impassable for Emergency Service respondents, and flood waters threaten the health, safety, and the properties of the public. The subject roadways are heavily used by the public and create east to west connectivity for the City and provide access to important public buildings, including Aventura Charter Elementary and Middle School. The scope of work includes complete reconstruction of NE 191st St, NE 29th Ave, and NE 188th St including raising the roadway elevation above flood levels, drainage system, catch basin, manholes, water quality treatment components, drainage outfall, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, landscaping, and street lighting.

a. What specific purpose or goal will be achieved by the funds requested?



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This project will reduce flooding and stormwater system overflows that inundate the rights of way, which negatively affects public health. During flood events the water pools in the rights of way instead of flowing through the undersized existing system, which increases the likelihood the public will come into contact with it. The proposed project will protect the public against flood and storm surge related hazards.

b. What activities and services will be provided to meet the intended purpose of these funds?

Complete reconstruction of NE 191st St, NE 29th Ave, and NE 188th St including raising the roadway elevation above flood levels, drainage system, catch basin, manholes, water quality treatment components, drainage outfall, curbs, gutters, sidewalks, landscaping, and street lighting.

c. What direct services will be provided to citizens by the appropriation project?

This project will protect the general public from harm by improving the ability for emergency vehicles to use this roadway during increasingly severe rainfall events that flood the roadway completely.

d. Who is the target population served by this project? How many individuals are expected to be served?

General population. City of Aventura is home to over 40,000 residents and receives well over 25 million visitors a year.

This project will improve physical health, protect the public from environmental harm, improve transportation conditions, and increase economic activity by improving the roadways and infrastructure. The outcome will be measured by a reduced number and severity of flooding events and improved safety.
