HERE'S THE FIGHT

The Senate Fiscal Policy Committee passed two bills that drew crowds of testimony from people on both sides of the aisle:

SB 256: PUBLIC UNION REFORM

SENATOR INGOGLIA

RAISES THE BAR FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYEE UNIONS

- **HIGHLIGHTS:** REQUIRES A SIGNED MEMBERSHIP FORM FROM EACH MEMBER
- BANS PAYCHECK DEDUCTION FOR DUES, REQUIRES MORE THAN 60% MEMBERSHIP OR RISK DECERTIFICATION
- MOSTLY EXCLUDES LAW ENFORCEMENT, CORRECTIONAL OFFICERS AND FIREFIGHTERS.

SB 236: CIVIL REMEDIES - SENATOR HUTSON

CHANGES CIVIL JUSTICE SYSTEM - FROM LOWERING THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS FOR NEGLIGENCE FROM 4 TO 2
YEARS TO MODIFYING THE 'BAD FAITH' FRAMEWORK.

SB 254: ANTI-TRANS BILL

FIRST COMMITTEE: SENATE HEALTH POLICY

Florida should be expanding access to health care, not limiting it for members of the LGBTQ+ community.

Among other things, this bill would ban young people from accessing gender affirming care treatments and regulate gender affirming care for adults.

SB 202: UNIVERSAL PRIVATE SCHOOL VOUCHER EXPANSION - SENATOR SIMON PASSED ITS FINAL COMMITTEE.

Democratic Bills on the Move

SB 130: GREYSON'S LAW

Sponsored by Senator Berman, Greyson's Law is headed to the Senate floor with unanimous support during its committee process. Greyson's Law will expand the list of factors courts must consider when deciding if shared parental responsibility would be detrimental to a child.

In the wake of the tragic death of Greyson Kessler, Greyson's Law will help children under the threat of abuse from a parent to have legal protection, and give the other parent power under the law to protect that child from abuse.

SB 184: HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION FOR FIRST RESPONDERS

Sponsored by Senator Polsky, this bill will expand a current property tax to include surviving spouses of first responders who died in the line of duty.

SB 508: PROBLEM-SOLVING COURTS

Sponsored by Senator Rouson, this bill revises three statutes that govern admission and participation in "Problem-solving courts", courts designed as pre-trial intervention programs that afford the opportunity to get the help one needs and avoid criminal convictions.

SB 430: ABANDONED AND HISTORIC CEMETERIES

Sponsored by Senator Powell, this bill establishes the Historic Cemeteries Program Advisory Council, with the goal of maintaining and improving cemeteries across the state. The bill focuses specifically on helping cemeteries that have been abandoned for over 50 years, as well as African American cemeteries in the University of South Florida's Black Cemetery Network.



SB 902: TYRE SAMPSON ACT

Sponsored by Senator Thompson, the Tyre Sampson Act aims to improve safety on permanent amusement rides by requiring them to have a report on file with the Department of Agriculture within a specified timeframe. This bill also authorizes the department to conduct unannounced inspections of amusement park rides and revises the circumstances under which the owner or manager of the ride is required to report incidents.

This bill is in memory of <u>Tyre Sampson</u>, the fourteen-year-old who tragically passed away after the mismanagement of the Orlando FreeFall drop tower in Icon Park.

ON THE FLOOR

Highlighting a few bills that passed on the Senate floor week 2:

SB 144: Lactation Spaces:

Sponsored by Senator Berman - Establishes lactation areas in all county courthouses.

SB 286: Legal Instruments

Sponsored by Senator Powell - Allows lenders to pursue rental income from third party investors

Here's a glance other bills filed by Senate Democrats that were heard in committee during Week 2:

<u>SB 114</u> Tax Exemptions for Diapers & Incontinence Products - Leader Lauren Book - *Creates permanent tax break for children & adult diapers.*<u>SB 290</u> Public School Student Progression for Students with Disabilities - Senator Shervin Jones - *Authorizes a parent to retain his or her child in Pre-K if that child has a disability and is enrolled through the state-run Pre-K finance programs*

<u>SB 292</u> Healthy Food Financing Initiative Program - Senator Shevrin Jones - *Revises requirements for the Food Financing program.*

<u>SB 506</u> - Comprehensive Waste Reduction & Recycling Plan - Senator Linda Stewart - *Requires DEP to create a waste reduction & recycling plan.*

<u>SB 734</u> Saltwater Intrusion Vulnerability Assessments - Senator Tina Polsky - Authorizes the Department of Environmental Protection to provide grants to coastal counties to assess how vulnerable these communities may be to saltwater intrusion

<u>SM 848</u> People of Iran - Senator Bobby Powell - *Urges congress to stand in support of the fight for freedom of the people of Iran*

<u>SB 938</u> Operation & Administration of the Baker Act - Senator Tracie Davis - *Updates & modernizes the Baker Act handbook.*

<u>SB 1002</u> Motor Vehicle Glass - Senator Linda Stewart - **Prohibits motor** vehicle repair shops from offering incentives to a customer in exchange for making an insurance claim for motor vehicle glass repair

<u>SB 1004</u> High School Equivalency Diplomas - Senator Torres - **Prohibits** school boards from requiring students to take specified courses before taking the high school equivalency examination if the student can pass a practice test

<u>SB 1268</u> Urban Agriculture Pilot Projects - Senator Rouson - *Redefines the term "urban agriculture" to include new commercial agriculture uses*
